

# Unesco chief urges world to help Pakistan

NEWSHERA: Director General Unesco Irina Bokoba on Tuesday said the international community should come to the help of Pakistan as no country alone could deal with such huge devastation caused by the recent floods in the country.

A 10-member Unesco delegation visited the Kandar Camp-I in Nowshera. Talking to reporters, the Unesco head said that provision of clean drinking water, medicines and food was

the priority of her organisation and added that Unesco would launch an assessment process of the losses caused by the floods to provide assistance to the affected people. She said that her organisation would appeal to the international community to provide funds for rehabilitation of the affected people.

Speaking on the occasion, Shahnaz Wazir Ali, special assistant to the prime minister, said that so far Rs1.9 billion had been donated to the Prime Minister's Relief Fund.
